

Peace and Earth Meeting
October 10, 2010

Present: Kitti and Susan

Kitti proposed donating \$50 to No More Victims, pending approval of other P & E members. There was a letter from Manna Food Bank saying that we made a donation of 104 pounds of food (this came from Susan and her neighbor) on September 20, 2010. Susan said she had a banner made that says ASHEVILLE FRIENDS MEETING. It is vinyl and is two by six feet. This will be useful for tabling or marking Friends presence at community events.

Interfaith Power and Light (a group of faith communities in 36 states) sent a letter out about reducing carbon footprint by developing program to emphasize low carbon food development. Kitti has a concern about this and is seeking more information. She will stay in contact with them, and she proposed that we provide more information to the Meeting and maybe have a low-carbon meal at some point this winter. She will obtain recipes that would be useful for low-carbon meals.

Susan felt that growing tomatoes and blueberries was not very successful (blueberries are still growing, however) at the Meeting House. Our experience is that growing food is not suitable at the Meeting House.
