

Memorial Meeting for Alan Scott Robinson

Alan Scott Robinson, 67, died at Solace Hospice Care in Asheville, North Carolina on February 7, with his husband, David Russell Spicer and youngest son, Daniel Robinson, at his side. Just two hours before, his partner of previous decades, Jim Cavener, had visited Alan for the last time.

Alan's parents, his oldest son Samuel and a brother, Norman, preceded him in death.
